Clinic Descriptions

Option A

- Hart Farm Clinic: \$125. Sessions lasts 2 hours each and will consist of no more than 5 riders per group. Each session will begin with basic flatwork and move onto gymnastic and show jump exercises.

Option B

-Burgundy Hollow Clinic: \$150. Cross country clinic. Sessions last 2 hours each and will consist of no more than 5 riders per group.

- Ride in both clinics: \$225. Save \$50!
